

2. In the "Minimum Standard Requirements for 200 MBBS Admissions Annually Regulations, 1999", under Schedule-I – 'ACCOMMODATION IN THE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND ITS ASSOCIATED TEACHING HOSPITALS', Sub-heading 'A-College', 'A.1 – General', information relating to Online Faculty Attendance Monitoring Systems (OFAMOS) under the Digital Mission Mode Project (DMMP), Point (a) shall be substituted and numbered as under:

"A.1.21(a)

All Medical Colleges/Institutions shall install biometric attendance machine for regularly capturing the attendance of human resources as specified in these regulations.

The biometric attendance shall be made available on the Medical College Website in the form of daily attendance dashboard. The Council may seek from the Medical Colleges/Institutions, such record of attendances during or after assessment.

The maintenance of the biometric attendance system shall be the responsibility of the Medical Colleges/ Institutions. The Dean/ Principal at the discretion of the Council, shall be required to furnish an undertaking by way of an affidavit stating that the enrolment of human resources in the biometric system has been ensured in a trusted environment and the report of the biometric attendance, is authentic and correct.

The financial burden arising on account of setting up of biometric attendance system and human resources enrolment shall be borne by the respective Medical Colleges / Institutions."

3. In the "Minimum Standard Requirements for 200 MBBS Admissions Annually Regulations, 1999", under Schedule-I – 'ACCOMMODATION IN THE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND ITS ASSOCIATED TEACHING HOSPITALS', Sub-heading 'B-Teaching Hospital', 'B.1 – General Remarks', Clause 11 shall be substituted as under:

"B.1.11

- (a) Each and every college /institute shall have its own website wherein a hyperlink shall be made available as '**Information under MSR Clause B.1.11**' on the Home page of the Website, which shall contain the following details in the form of sub links, to be updated in the first week of every month: -

- a) Details of Dean, Principal and Medical Supdt. including their name, qualification complete address with telephone and STD code, fax and E-mail etc.
- b) Teaching as well as non-teaching staff.
- c) Details of the sanctioned intake capacity of various Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses.
- d) List of students admitted merit-wise category-wise in MBBS and Postgraduate courses for the current and previous academic sessions.
- e) Any research publications during the last one year.
- f) Details of any Continuing Medical Education programmes, conferences and/or any academic activities conducted by the institution.
- g) Details of any awards and achievement received by the students or faculty.

- h) Details of the affiliating University and its Vice-Chancellor and Registrar.
- i) Results of all the examinations of last one year.
- j) Detailed status of recognition of all the courses.
- k) Details of clinical material in the hospital.

(b) Each and every college /institute shall maintain Daily Biometric Attendance Dashboard of human resources as specified in these regulations. The Attendance Dashboard shall be provided as a sub link under the main link '**Information under MSR Clause B.1.11**' on Home page of the College website under heading '**Biometric attendance Dashboard**'.

संशोधन अधिसूचना

सं. भा.आ.प.-34(41)/2019-मेड./106975.—भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद अधिनियम, 1956 (1956 का 102) की धारा 33 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का इस्तेमाल करते हुए, भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद "प्रति वर्ष 250 एमबीबीएस दाखिलों के लिए न्यूनतम मानक शर्तें विनियमावली, 1999" को पुनः संशोधित करने के लिए केंद्र सरकार की पूर्व स्वीकृति से एतद्वारा निम्नलिखित विनियम बनाती है, नामतः:

- 1(i) इन विनियमों को "प्रति वर्ष 250 एमबीबीएस दाखिलों के लिए न्यूनतम मानक शर्तें (संशोधन) विनियमावली, 2019" कहा जाएगा।
- (ii) ये सरकारी राजपत्र में उनके प्रकाशन की तारीख से प्रवृत्त होंगे।
2. "प्रति वर्ष 250 एमबीबीएस दाखिलों के लिए न्यूनतम मानक शर्तें विनियमावली, 1999" में, अनुसूची-I- 'मेडिकल कॉलेज या चिकित्सा संस्थान और उसके संबद्ध अध्यापन अस्पताल', उप-शीर्षक 'क-कॉलेज', 'क. I-सामान्य' के अंतर्गत, डिजिटल मिशन मोड परियोजना (डीएमएमपी) के अंतर्गत ऑनलाइन संकाय उपस्थिति मॉनीटरिंग प्रणाली (ओएफएमओएस), बिंदु (क) से संबंधित सूचना निम्नलिखित रूप में प्रतिस्थापित और क्रमांकित की जाएगी:

"क.1.21(क)

सभी मेडिकल कॉलेज/संस्थान, इन विनियमों में यथाविनिर्दिष्ट मानव संसाधनों की उपस्थिति नियमित रूप से प्राप्त करने के लिए बायोमेट्रिक उपस्थिति मशीन संस्थापित करेंगे।

बायोमेट्रिक उपस्थिति दैनिक उपस्थिति-बोर्ड के रूप में मेडिकल कॉलेज की वेबसाइट पर उपलब्ध कराई जाएगी। परिषद, मेडिकल कॉलेजों/संस्थानों से मूल्यांकन के दौरान या इसके पश्चात उपस्थितियों का ऐसा रिकार्ड मांग सकती है।

बायोमेट्रिक उपस्थिति प्रणाली का अनुरक्षण मेडिकल कॉलेजों/संस्थानों की जिम्मेदारी होगी। परिषद के विवेकाधिकार पर डीन/प्रधानाचार्य के लिए यह आवश्यक होगा कि वह एक शपथपत्र के रूप में ऐसा वचनपत्र प्रस्तुत करे, जिसमें यह उल्लेख किया गया हो कि बायोमेट्रिक प्रणाली में मानव संसाधनों का नामांकन, एक विश्वासप्राप्त वातावरण में सुनिश्चित किया गया है और बायोमेट्रिक उपस्थिति की रिपोर्ट प्रामाणिक और सही है।
